Little Leaders Academy includes children six weeks to five years old. To give each child the best care, we have divided our programs into 6 classes: Farm Room 1, Farm Room 2, Forest Room, Jungle Room, Desert Room, and Ocean Room. Children learn and grow at different paces, so we determine a child's readiness to move up to the next class by milestones as well as age.



Garden Room

This room is designed for children **six weeks old until walking**. In this room, we follow each child's natural rhythm for eating, sleeping, and playing. We believe consistency is key, so we make it a high priority to work with parents to keep their infant's schedule. As the child gets closer to transitioning to the next room, we try to establish a cohesive class schedule where multiple children eat, sleep, and play at the same time.

Farm Room

Farm Room is designed for children who are **fully walking**. This room is more structured, especially for the older children. We have snack time and lunch time together, as well as start to introduce group art and music. We still refer to the child's schedule when it comes to sleeping (especially when they are first moved into the class); however, by the time the child is ready to move up to the next class, we transition them to a group schedule and sleeping on a cot, rather than in a crib.

Forest Room

Our Forest Room is all about **transitioning your child from the infant stage into the toddler stage**. The curriculum for this class includes twelve units of "bite-sized" Bible lessons for toddlers with 60 lessons total. Additionally, students will begin to learning letters, numbers, shapes, etc, as well as participate in activities like art and music and play-based learning. Children will have a set time for snack, lunch, nap, and play, and will begin each day with Circle Time. We also work alongside parents when it comes to helping their child potty train.

Jungle Room

Our Jungle Room is set for little explorers! This classroom is for children who are **ready for more structure and learning**. We start to introduce Circle Time each morning, as well as an interactive, slow-paced, curriculum called "God's Little Explorers". Each day is filled with group activities such as art and music, as well as independent play. Children will have a set time for snack, lunch, nap, and play. We also work alongside parents when it comes to helping their child potty train.

Desert Room

Desert Room is for children who **turn three by September 1st as set by state guidelines**, and who are **fully potty trained**. We use the curriculum, "Bible Truths from A-Z" in this class, and also do a daily circle time to focus on days, months, weather, etc. Children will have a set time for snack, lunch, nap, and play. We encourage each child to nap after lunch, but simply laying quietly is acceptable for those who do not fall asleep.

Ocean Room

This room is for children who **turn four by September 1st as set by state guidelines**. This class is a year-long program that blends K-4 and Kindergarten curriculum, using both "Voyage to Discovery" and "God's Creation from A-Z" by My Father's World. The curriculum is a faith-based program that includes alphabet and numeric learning, and it also focuses on large and fine motor skills. We encourage each child to nap after lunch each day, but simply laying quietly is acceptable for those who do not fall asleep. We encourage all of our students enrolled in 4-year old preschool to be at school at least four half days per week, as this class is focused on Kindergarten-readiness and lessons build upon each other.

Registration Fee

\$175 yearly per child | Non-refundable | Must be paid before your child(ren) can start | This fee covers the costs of your child's curriculum (minus the infant rooms), crafts/activities, and various classroom expenses. For DHHS families, this fee is NOT covered, and is expected to be paid in full by the family.

Billing

Billing is done weekly on Monday for the prior week. The due date for that bill is the following Monday. It is expected that we will receive payment by the due date. If the payment is late by 2 weeks, then the child is no longer able to attend LLA until the balance is paid in full OR a formal written/signed payment plan is put in place with Michelle Berlin, Director or Loree Pastine, Admissions.

Discounted Rates

For families with multiple children enrolled in our programs, a 10% discount will be applied to the tuition of the oldest child.

For military and law enforcement families, Little Leaders Academy would like to show our gratitude for your service by offering a 10% discount for each child enrolled at our facility.

Enrollment & Attendance

REGISTRATION

To officially register your child, a Brightwheel account must be created. Once you have toured our facility, and it is determined that your child is a good fit for our program, a Brightwheel invitation will be sent to your email address. Once you have filled in all of the information fields, the school will apply the registration fee to your account. This registration fee will need to be paid in full before your child's first day of school. This fee is non-refundable, and will reserve your child's spot through the second Friday in September. If your child has not attended by that time and no communication has been provided to the staff, your child's spot will be cancelled and given to the next child on the waitlist.

Once your child is enrolled, you will need to provide us with an updated copy of the child's immunization record. The immunization record must be on file before the child's first day of attendance. For parents who choose not to vaccinate, you must provide a valid immunization waiver from the local health department before your child's first day of attendance. All children must also have a health appraisal on file within 30 days of initial attendance. Physicals must be updated yearly for infants and toddlers, and every two years for preschoolers. The physical exam can be performed within the preceding three months for infants, within the preceding 6 months for toddlers, and within the preceding 12 months for preschoolers.

All new students will be under a 30-day probationary period beginning the first day of attendance to determine if the child is a good fit for the program. It is understood and agreed that the first thirty days of enrollment constitute a probationary period during which period Little Leaders Academy may, in its absolute discretion, terminate a student's enrollment, for any reason in the best interest of the program.

ATTENDANCE

Your child's schedule must be submitted at least two weeks in advance. Failure to provide a schedule, or changes made to your child's schedule with less than two weeks' notice, will incur a \$30 charge. This charge does not apply to days your child is out due to illness.

Each child is allotted five sick days per year. Vacations and absences from daycare/preschool need to be notified to your child's teacher or a staff member a minimum of two weeks in advance. Failure to notify staff of your child's absence will result in a \$30 charge.

There is a \$20/week fee to hold your child's spot during vacations, and a \$50/month fee for extended absences (i.e. Summer Break).

EXTENDED CARE

LLA is open from 6:30am-6pm Monday through Friday. Our programs run from 8am-3:15pm. If you would like care before or after our regular hours, there is \$5/hour fee for those 3+ years, and \$7/hour for those 2 years of age and younger. Please see our tuition pages for a breakdown of extended care costs.

A \$1/minute charge will be billed for children who are not picked up by 6pm.



WITHDRAWAL & TERMINATION

Parents/guardians may withdraw their child from Little Leaders Academy for any reason. A written withdrawal notice must be provided to the director no less than ten business days prior to the last date of attendance. Failure to provide proper notice will result in a charge equal to the ten business days.

Little Leaders Academy has the right to terminate services for a child at any point. Termination will be effective upon notification to the parents.

FEE POLICY

Parents/guardians are responsible to pay all tuition and fees. Failure to pay any amount when due may result in your child being suspended or dismissed from Little Leaders Academy. You will be billed through Brightwheel; parents have the option to pay via credit card through Brightwheel, or in person via cash or check.

Required Items

While our school is happy to provide most of the items needed for daily activities in the classroom, there is a list of items that parents are expected to provide. All items sent from home must be clearly labeled with the child's first and last name.

GARDEN & FARM ROOMS

- Diapers, wipes, and diaper rash cream (medication form must be filled out for cream)
- Bottles and cups with liquids: pre-made and clearly labeled with the child's first and last name, the date, the contents inside, and the amount
- Snacks: clearly labeled with the child's first and last name, the date, the contents inside. All meal items and snacks are to be cut to the appropriate size by the parent.
- Blanket and a fitted crib sheet (optional) for those napping on cots; LLA provides crib sheets for those napping in cribs
- At least two spare outfits placed in a clear bag and labeled with the child's first and last name
- Sunscreen for outdoor time (medication form must be filled out)

FOREST & JUNGLE ROOMS

- Diapers/pull-ups, wipes, and diaper rash cream (medication form must be filled out for cream)
- Lunch: clearly labeled with the child's first and last name, the date, and the contents inside. All meal items and snacks are to be cut to the appropriate size by the parent.
- Snacks: clearly labeled with the child's first and last name, the date, the contents inside.
- Blanket and pillow for rest time (nap mats are permitted); comfort items such as blankets, stuffed animals, and pacifiers are only permitted at nap time
- At least two spare outfits placed in a clear bag and labeled with the child's first and last name; please make sure that socks and underwear are included as part of the spare outfit set
- Sunscreen for outdoor time (medication form must be filled out)
- Hat, gloves, scarf, coat, and snow pants in the winter months
- Sippy cup/water bottle; infant-style bottles and sippy cups with nipples are not to be used in these rooms

DESERT & OCEAN ROOMS

Same as Forest and Jungle, but without the requirement of diapers, pull-ups, and wipes



Program Information

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

Little Leaders Academy admits children of any race, color, nationality, and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. Little Leaders Academy does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality, or ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, and other center-administered programs.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Little Leaders Academy is open 6:30am-6pm Monday through Friday. Please see the attached calendar for specific days that our facility will be closed or have adjusted hours.

SCHOOL CLOSINGS

If Faith Christian School is closed due to inclement weather, Little Leaders Academy will still be open for daycare only. This means that our Desert and Ocean rooms will not teach curriculum as normal, but will have daycare available. Our hours on these days will be 7:30am-5pm. Should LLA close due to inclement weather, you will be notified via Brightwheel by 5:30am the day of the closure.

FOOD SERVICE

Parents are responsible for providing all meal items for their children. All children in the Forest, Jungle, Desert, and Ocean rooms should have a morning and afternoon snack, as well lunch, sent in each day. Infants in the Farm rooms should have prepared bottles, meals, and/or snacks provided each day to meet their individual feeding schedules. On special occasions such as holidays, a special treat may be provided, in which case a permission slip will be sent home and a parent signature must be provided authorizing consent for the child to receive the snack.

FIELD TRIPS

In the event that a field trip is planned, parents will be notified ahead of time, and a permission slip must be signed and turned in prior to the child being permitted to leave campus.

OUTDOOR PLAY

Children in attendance for three hours or more must go outside (weather permitting) as required by Michigan state law. Because of which, each class will have at least one 30-minute outdoor recess per day. Children must have proper clothing for each season (including but not limited to a jacket, gloves, hat, scarf, boots, etc.). In the case that a child does not have proper clothing, they will remain inside with a staff member.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

At Little Leaders Academy, we firmly believe that the Word of God sets the boundaries for our behavior based on the standards and characteristics of Christ. We believe that setting limits and boundaries based on God's Word gives clear direction and guidelines for all people, including children who live out and apply it throughout their lives. Learning self-discipline will help children to develop their social and behavioral skills so they can live peaceably with others.

Discipline, by definition, is the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using punishment to correct disobedience. The staff at Little Leaders Academy follow a 4-step process when it comes to discipline. First, the child must know and be instructed in the expectations placed upon him/her. Second, the staff will redirect a child that is disobeying or not following the rules. Third, when a child has behaved wrongly, the teacher will reprove the child. All actions have consequences, and the time of reproof is to simply let the child know that he/she has made a poor decision, and it must be addressed and corrected. This will be done privately between the teacher and child so as to not embarrass or belittle the child. Fourth, and last, comes rebuke. The staff will get an understanding of the situation and explain what the correct behavior should have been. The staff will encourage the child to respond verbally so he/she knows what he/she did wrong, and what the correct decision is. If the child is three years of age or older and persists in a disruptive behavior after redirection and reproof, they will be placed in a "time-out" from activities.

If the behavior continues, the child will be sent to the office where administrative staff can address the problem and seek to come to a positive conclusion with the child. Finally, if the situation does not improve, the parents will be contacted. Termination of services will be left to the judgement of the daycare director.

*At Little Leaders Academy, the staff is not allowed to administer corporal punishment in any form or for any reason. This includes intentionally belittling, embarrassing the child verbally, or secluding the child for disciplinary purposes.

Health & Illness

According to MDSS Rule 400.528, each child/student must have a Health Appraisal form on file:

1. Within 30 days of initial attendance and renewed yearly for all ages
2. Signed by a doctor stating: the child's health condition, any restrictions, and current immunization records



GUIDELINES

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If ill at home, parents must notify a staff member at Little Leaders Academy of their child's illness, and make arrangements will need to be made by the parents to have him/her cared for outside of the facility. Children are to be kept home if they have any of the following symptoms:

- A temperature of 100° or more. A child must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications
- Conjunctivitis (pink eye), Bronchitis, or Impetigo
- Rashes that cannot be identified, are contagious, or have not been checked by a physician.
- Diarrhea and/or vomiting due to an illness within the last 24 hours.
- Severe cold with fever and/or discharge from the nose or eyes
- Any contagious disease such as Scarlet Fever, measles, mumps, chicken pox, meningitis, Hand/Foot/Mouth, etc.
- If a child is obviously sick, pale, pasty, irritable, or listless

Please be sure to notify Little Leaders Academy if your child has come down with a serious illness, or if he/she were prescribed medication for a contagious illness. Your child may return to school when he/she has been on such medication for the prescribed amount of time for the contagious period, and/or when they have been 24 hours fever free without the help of fever-reducing medications.

- All primary staff at Little Leaders Academy are certified in First Aid and CPR

STAFF ROLE

We believe that many communicable diseases can be prevented with appropriate hygiene and sanitation practices. Staff and volunteer illness will follow similar guidelines. An ill staff member will be responsible for making the right decision based on the severity of the illness. If the staff member does come to work and the illness seems to worsen, he/she will be sent home until well again. Since people can carry disease asymptotically, the staff at Little Leaders Academy will carry out routine sanitation procedures to protect against any potential illnesses. Some sanitation procedures include, but are not limited to:

- Handwashing
 - Before preparing, serving, or eating food/drinks
 - After playing outside
 - After sneezing or blowing nose
 - After using the restroom or diapering a child
 - After all contact with bodily fluids

- Cleaning & Sanitizing Equipment
 - Countertops and tabletops are cleaned before and after the food is served
 - Bare floors are swept and mopped at the end of every day
 - Toys are sprayed or washed at the end of each day, as well as when soiled
 - Carpets are vacuumed at the end of the day
 - Any surface contaminated with bodily fluids will be cleaned immediately
- An ill child will be isolated away from the rest of the group and his/her parents will be called immediately. All toys and materials handled by the child will be sanitized. Parents must pick up their child within an hour of being notified about the illness. The child must be kept home until he/she is well again.

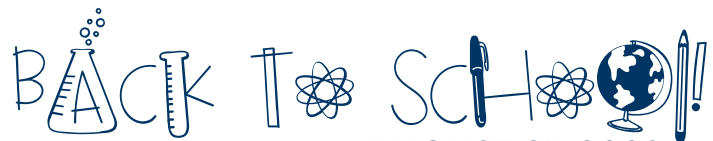
