TABLE RENTAL: Re-sale item tables are \$20 for each 8-foot table. If you wish to bring a garment rack, there will be am additional charge of \$2 per rack. If you will also be selling larger items for the Big Ticket Room, there will also be an additional charge of \$4 per item, with a limit of 10 items per seller. If you desire to bring your own table to display items on, you will receive a discounted registration fee of \$15 per table. All tables brought in should be 8 feet in length or less.

BIG TICKET ITEMS: Big ticket items can be sold with or without the purchase of a table rental. Big ticket items are \$4 per item, with a limit of 10 items per seller. All big ticket items will be assigned a number before being set out and the number will be noted on a corresponding listing sheet. This is how we will keep track of payouts at the end of the event.

CANCELLATION: If cancellation in necessary, a 50% refund will be offered up to two weeks before the sale, provided that we have a waitlisted person available to fill your spot. If no waitlisted seller exists, or. if you cancel within two weeks of the sale, non refunds will be given.

SET-UP: We will be offering setup on Friday evening (7/29) from 5-7:30pm. We strongly recommend that you set up on Friday, or at least get all items dropped off to your table space on Friday night. Please contact Alyssa Schlump (see email address below) if you have a situation that prevents you from setting up the night before. Sellers will be allowed into the building at 7:30am Saturday morning for any last minute setup. All sellers are required to be present at their table spots by 7:45am.

SHOPPING: Doors will open to the public at 8am. Refreshments will be available for purchase during the sale.
